Funeral services will be held Tuesday in St. Gabriel Church, Alhambra, Calif., for Vincent Casciato, 81, of 1117 S. Azalea Drive, Alhambra, formerly of Youngstown. He died in his sleep Saturday morning at his residence.

Mr. Casciato was born in Pescocostanzo, Aquila, Italy, June 5, 1882, and came to Youngstown in 1900. He owned and operated a tailor shop on E. Federal Street, where he made men's suits for about 30 years and later worked as a tailor for Strouss-Hersberg Co. store 15 years. He moved to California in 1948 and had worked as a tailor there until his death. He was a founder and past president of the Duca Degli Abruzzi Society here.

Besides his wife, the former Angeline Mastriana, he leaves three daughters, Misses Elvira and Cloe Casciato, both of Alhambra, and Mrs. Yola Earnhart of Batesville, Ark.; two sons, George and John, both of Phoenix, Ariz.; seven grandchildren, and 10 great-grandchildren.
