

Vincent Conti Dies; Owned Grocery Store

POLAND — Vincent (Jim) Conti, 82, of 169 Edgewater Drive, Poland, owner and operator of Conti Grocery on Shehy Street for 30 years, died of a heart ailment at 5:20 p.m. Sunday in St. Elizabeth Hospital, where he had been a patient five weeks.

Mr. Conti was born Feb. 25, 1889, in Caroville, Campobasso, Italy, a son of Joseph and Rose Dagarone Conti, coming here from Europe 68 years ago. He retired in 1955 from the Coupling Department of the Youngstown Sheet & Tube Co., and was a member of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church and the Carovillese Society.

Besides his wife, the former Antoinette Riccilli, whom he married 58 years ago, he leaves three daughters, Mrs. Rose Sferra of Boardman, Mrs. Virginia DiYorio of Youngstown and Mrs. Josephine Fedders of Hubbard, and four grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
