Mrs. Libery, 96; Rites in Calif.

Services will be held at 9 a.m. Monday in Mission Church, San Gabriel, Calif., for Mrs. Mary Zito Libery, 96, of 1516 New Ave., Apt. F., San Gabriel, formerly of Youngstown, who died of a heart ailment Thursday in San Gabriel Community Hospital.

Mrs. Libery was born Feb. 8, 1887, in San Pietro, Avellana, Italy, a daughter of Pasquale and Anna Maria Izzi Mastriana, coming to the United States more than 80 years ago, and moving from Youngstown to California more than 20 years ago. While here, she had been a seamstress in the alteration department of the Strouss-Hirshberg Co. and was a member of Mount Carmel Church.
