

Attorney Anne Mastriana, 80; teacher, assistant prosecutor

Atty. Anne Mastriana, 80, of 4233 Chester Drive, died of a heart ailment this morning in Southside Medical Center.

Miss Mastriana was born Sept. 10, 1909, in Youngstown, a daughter of Frank and Orsolina Mastriana. She attended Kent State University and had a law degree from Youngstown College and a bachelor's degree in art from Youngstown State University. She taught in the Youngstown Schools and at Youngstown State University for several years.

She was an assistant Mahoning County prosecuting attorney for 12 years and was in private practice for many years in the Bank One building before moving her office to Market Street. She was recently honored for 50 years of service to the American Bar Association.
